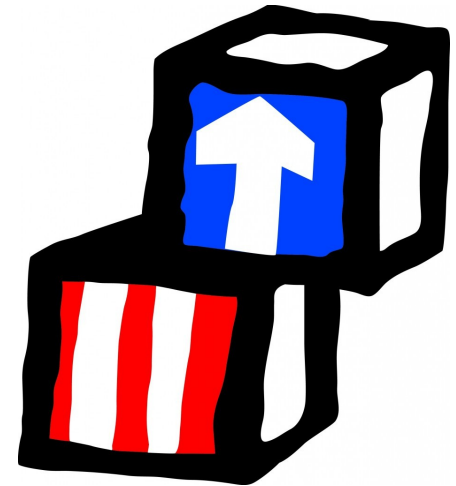

8 GREAT REASONS TO ATTEND HEAD START

Transportation

We provide safe transportation to and from Head Start on our own New York State DOT inspected buses, with monitors, and equipped with five point safety restraints.



Nutrition

Head Start children receive free meals (snacks for Home Based), with menus planned by a Registered Dietitian. We offer nutrition education to our children and families.



Health

We provide a comprehensive health screening for each child. This includes an assessment of growth and development, vision, hearing, and speech as well as assistance to families in finding medical and dental providers.

Mental Health

Head Start believes emotional and social growth depend on positive mental health. We have two mental



health care professionals on staff, accessible to all parents, children, and employees.

Education

Head Start is a school readiness program with experienced teachers who provide a safe, healthy and nurturing environment for children. Focus is on acquiring skills in math, science, literacy, language, social/emotional, physical health and development. We use Creative Curriculum which is aligned with NYS Preschool Early Learning Standards. Children learn through what they like best – play! Through play children learn to express thoughts and feelings, increase self-confidence, and have positive relationships with others.



Special Needs

We have two integrated classrooms where we work closely with community providers to ensure that each child is included in all activities.



Home Based

Home Based parents partner with staff to provide weekly learning experiences for

their own children. Group experiences are held twice a month for socialization with peers. Home Based families receive all Head Start services and activities.



Parent Involvement

Head Start provides you with the unique opportunity to become involved in your child's education from the very beginning. We ask you to tell us about your child, participate in classroom activities, make decisions for the program, and volunteer. Staff offer information on community resources and help you identify family strengths, interests, and goals.



Parents have the opportunity to learn leadership skills and effective parenting tips, and to participate in volunteer experiences that can be added to parent resumes!
